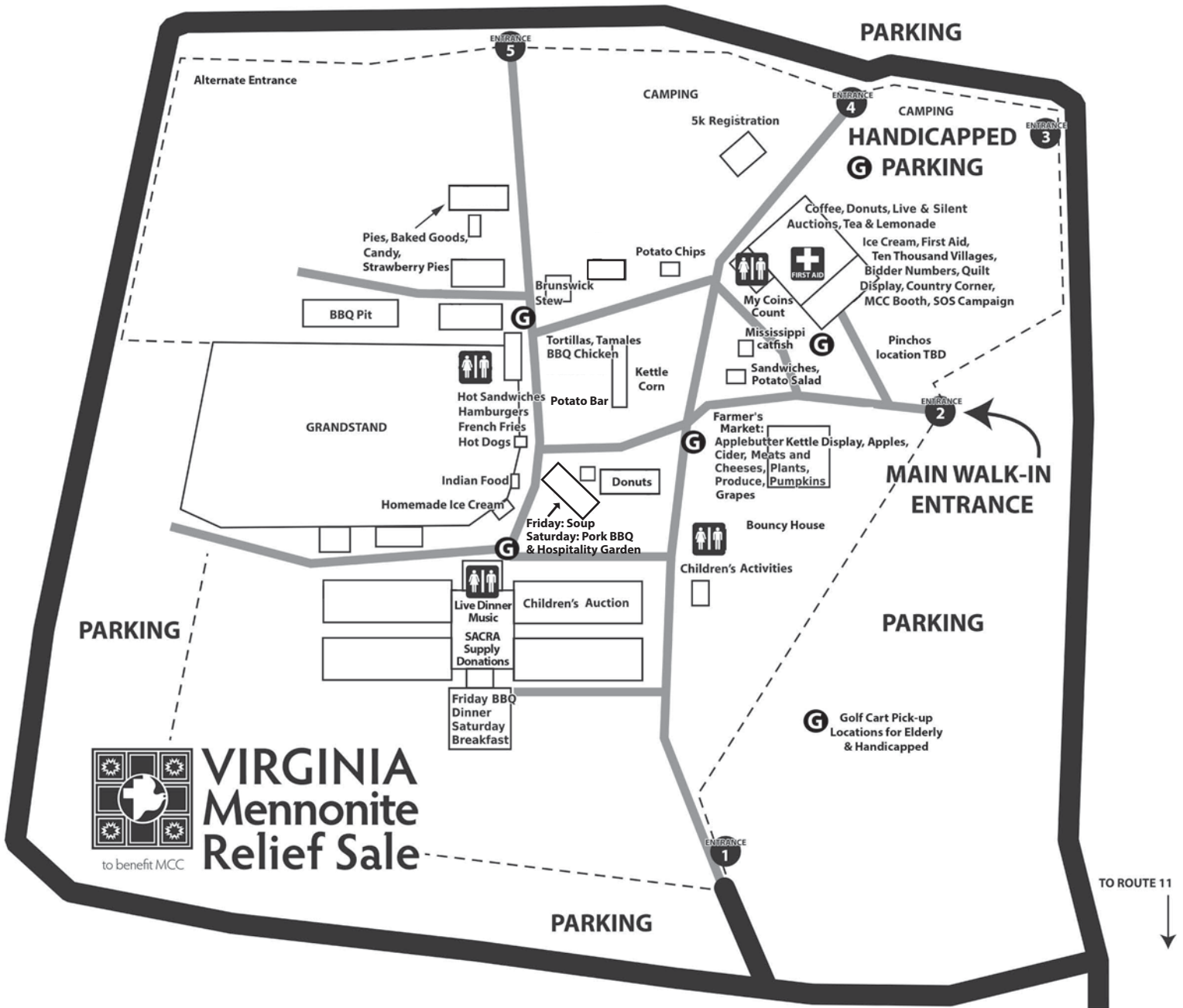

Each year the Virginia Mennonite Relief Sale raises hundreds of thousands of dollars for Mennonite Central Committee, whose tagline is relief, development, and peace in the name of Christ. This year we're offering a newish opportunity to add to the total giving through a "S.O.S. (Sharing Our Surplus) Campaign" and donating the money to MCC's work with refugees around the world. In its first 2 years, this initiative raised over \$75,000. You can help us reach our goal of \$50,000 by generously giving cash, check and credit card funds in addition to supporting the

auction and the sale of food and other items.



A special table will be set in the Everence tent outside on Friday evening and all day Saturday to receive such donations for MCC war and famine refugee relief.

Harvey Yoder, who is spearheading this initiative, encourages relief sale attendees to think of giving in the spirit of Jubilee—"over and above our regular tithes and offerings, and not result in decreased giving elsewhere." In his blogpost about the initiative, Yoder goes on to challenge us to "willingly become poorer for Christ's sake."

Yoder concludes his challenge with the words of the apostle Paul, responding to a famine in far off Judea: "Right now you have plenty and can help them; then at some other time they can share with you when you need it" (II Cor 9).

GENERAL AUCTION INFORMATION

NUMBERING OF SALE ITEMS

Items are numbered to give you an idea of the approximate time an item will be sold. If an item is numbered 1002, then that means it will be the second item sold in the half hour between 10:00 and 10:30. We normally sell about eighteen items per half hour. If we have time we will sell in that half hour items that were received too late to print in this auction listing.

PAYMENT FOR AUCTION ITEMS

Payment may be made by personal check, credit card, and cash.

AUCTIONEERS

Special thanks to our auctioneers who donate their time to make this sale possible. Please support them by bidding quickly and visibly. We have a lot of items and want to keep the auction moving. Thanks!

COMFORTERS AND QUILTS

COMFORTERS - Usually made from heavyweight materials and put together by knotting or using large stitches.

QUILTS - Usually made of lighter weight materials and quilted with very fine stitches.

TYPES OF QUILTS

- **PIECED** – Small pieces of material are sewn together to form a design. This is framed by a border and bound to finish off the raw edges.
- **APPLIQUED** – Pieces of material cut into decorative shapes are applied over the surface of another piece of fabric. These are sewn together with tiny hidden stitches.
- **STAMPED/PREPRINTED** – The top is one large piece of material with the design stamped on. These are quilted with fine stitches.

QUILT CARE

New quilts made with Dacron and polyester filler are usually washable. However it is advisable to put as little tension as possible on the threads. Wash gently with cool water. To dry, drape over several clotheslines to distribute the weight more evenly or lay the quilt on a flat surface over absorbent towels. A quilt should never be stored in plastic. Rather, it should be wrapped in a sheet or pillow case which allows it to breath. A quilt should be rolled rather than folded.
