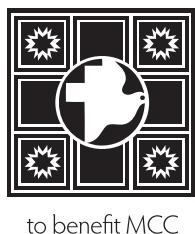

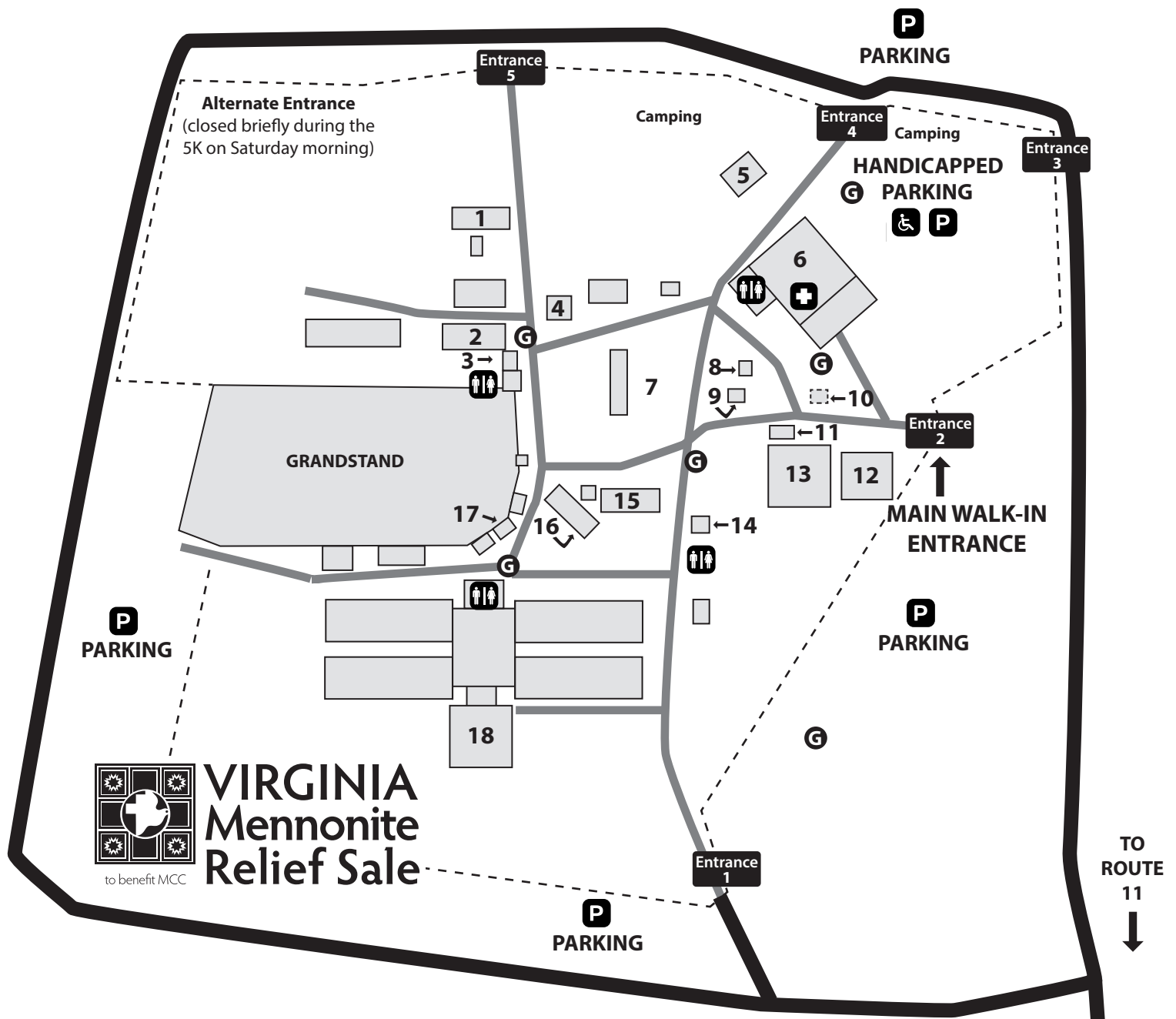

Sharing our Surplus (SOS) Campaign



Donations to Sharing our Surplus (SOS) support MCC refugee relief around the world. SOS's effort raised more than \$100,000 in 2024. This year we hope to match that level of support. Funds will be designated for MCC's ongoing relief work in **Gaza, Ukraine, South Sudan** and the **Democratic Republic of the Congo**.

Anonymous donors have pledged \$35,000 in matching funds. Of that \$10,000 has already been matched. So, every dollar, up to \$25,000, given to MCC via the Sharing Our Surplus campaign, will be matched dollar for dollar.

Items listed are in the order they will be sold. There may be additional items sold that were received after the print deadline and do not appear in this booklet. For the most up to date order, visit **www.varelielsale.bidwrangler.com/**. We estimate that 40 items will be sold each hour.

SIMULCAST AUCTION

Follow along at home to watch, listen and bid on your favorite items. In person bidding requires a numbered bid card. These are available at the cashiers table in the auction building.

Download our new auction app to follow along, search for "VA Relief Sale" in your app store or scan the QR code.



PAYMENT AND PICKUP

A 3% card process fee will be assessed for all debit and credit card payments. This allows all proceeds to be sent to MCC. A personal check and cash are also accepted. All items need to be paid and picked up by 3:00pm on Saturday. Payment can also be made from your online auction account via the app or web browser. You will be asked to show a paid invoice when picking up your items. Shipping can be arranged for smaller items at an additional cost.

SILENT AUCTION

The Silent Auction is only available for in person bidding. Register for a number at the auction cashier table in the auction building. Items will close on Saturday at 11:30 am and 12:30 pm.

COMFORTERS AND QUILTS

Comforters – Usually made from heavyweight materials and put together by knotting or using large stitches.

Quilts – Usually made of lighter weight materials and quilted with very fine stitches.

TYPES OF QUILTS

- **Pieced** – Small pieces of material are sewn together to form a design. This is framed by a border and bound to finish off the raw edges.
- **Appliquéd** – Pieces of material cut into decorative shapes are applied over the surface of another piece of fabric. These are sewn together with tiny hidden stitches.
- **Stamped/Preprinted** – The top is one large piece of material with the design stamped on. These are quilted with fine stitches.

QUILT CARE

New quilts made with cotton fabrics are usually washable. However it is advisable to put as little tension as possible on the threads. Wash gently with cool water. Quilts with red or blue in them may not be colorfast if fabrics were not prewashed. To dry, drape over several clotheslines to distribute the weight more evenly or lay the quilt on a flat surface over absorbent towels. A quilt should never be stored in plastic. Rather, it should be wrapped in a sheet or pillowcase which allows it to breathe. A quilt should be rolled rather than folded.
